3 HOW TO USE A VALLEY CUSTOM DOOR SPECIFICATION GUIDE

PRICING

All prices shown are LIST, please contact the customer service department to determine what discounts may apply.

All door and drawer front pricing is to be figured based on the square footage of each item. To determine the square footage, you must first round up the width and height size to the next whole inch, then multiply them together and divide by 144. There is a minimum charge of 1 square foot on doors and ½ square foot on drawer fronts.

All other products have price tables and instructions located in each product section.

Pricing is subject to change without notice.

NEW CUSTOMERS

All new customers will be set up as 50% down payment/C.O.D. Cash accounts until the Customer Information Form is filled out and returned for evaluation by our credit department. Until other payment terms have been established, all orders will require that a 50% down payment be received before they are scheduled for production.

PAYMENT TERMS

Based on the information supplied on the Customer Information Form, payment terms will be assigned by our credit department. If the Customer Information Form is not filled out, payment terms will automatically be 50% down payment/C.O.D. Cash, (all payments must be a cashier's check or money order.)

- Net/30 Days – Full balance is due 30 days from the **date of the invoice** (not to be confused with the monthly statement date). Credit limits will be set for all open accounts.
- C.O.D. Regular – A company or personal check will be accepted for payment upon delivery.
- C.O.D. Cash – A cashier's check or money order is required for payment upon delivery.
- 50% D.P. / C.O.D. Cash – A 50% down payment on each order by cashier's check or money order, balance paid by cashier's check or money order on delivery.
- VISA, MasterCard or American Express are accepted as alternative methods of payment to the terms listed above.

SHIPPING

All orders are packaged extremely well using heavy corrugated boxes and expandable bagged packing foam to protect our products while in transit. UPS is our primary shipper, but in some cases a common carrier is required. There is **no additional charge for packaging** your orders, but the actual shipping charges are not included in the cost of our products. A minimum of \$XX.XX will be charged to cover the cost of the skid for common carrier shipments.

FREIGHT DAMAGE

You must report freight damage immediately to your customer service representative. Products that have been damaged while in transit will be remade on a priority schedule and shipped out as soon as possible. We will process the freight claim with the carrier, but **you must save the damaged products and the packaging it came in** for the carrier to inspect if they choose. **If the delivery was made by a common carrier, you must make a notation on the bill of lading of any visible damage to the outside of the skid or packaging. If the delivery was made by UPS, you must save the damaged products and all of the packaging in order for us to file a claim. We reserve the right to have defective products returned for our inspection, and upon inspection, we will determine if charges will apply for the products remade.**

WARRANTY AND REMAKE POLICY

All of our products are guaranteed to be free from defect in material and workmanship for one year from the date of shipment. Warp tolerance on doors will be ⅛" from diagonal corners; size tolerance on doors and drawer boxes will be +/- 1/32". Valley Custom Door will expedite the production of replacements or repair of defective products as they were originally ordered and ship as soon as possible. Valley Custom Door will not be liable for additional costs incurred by the customer for finishing, installation, or labor to remove or install new product. We reserve the right to have defective products returned for inspection.

RUSH ORDERS

Orders requesting expedited service will be accepted based on our workload at the time. Please call your customer service representative for more information on availability and price.

PRICE QUOTATIONS

Depending on workload, requests for price quotes on standard items are usually returned the same day they are received. To help us give you an accurate quote, please provide as much information as possible, such as wood species, door styles, profiles, quantity, sizes and drawings for special custom items.

ORDERING

We accept orders in any of the following ways:

- Fax – 1-920-336-5956 (24 hours a day, 7 days a week)
- Email – contact customer service for order forms that can be emailed
- Phone – 1-800-236-8981 (Monday – Friday from 6:30 am to 4:30 pm CST) Orders taken over the phone will be **read back** for customer approval. Any corrections not made during the **read back** become the customer’s responsibility.

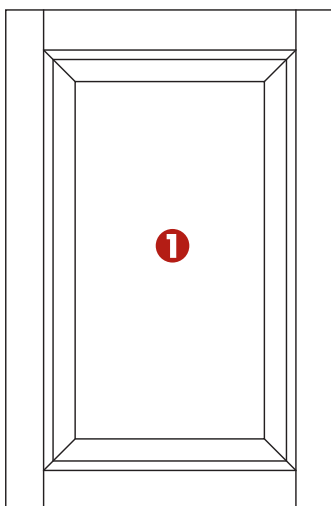
We manufacture the actual size listed on the order and do not work from opening sizes.

After an order is entered into our system, a Price Quotation will be faxed to you for confirmation of price, quantity and all order specifications. The Price Quotation must be signed and returned confirming that the order is correct as printed before the order can be scheduled for production. Any changes made BEFORE the order is signed off on will be made without penalty; changes made to an order AFTER it has been signed off on but is not yet in production, will incur additional charges. Changes to an order already in production will not be accepted. Call your customer service representative to check whether changes to your order can be made.

A confirming Order Acknowledgement with an estimated ship date will be faxed or emailed to you for your records.

STEPS TO FOLLOW WHEN ORDERING DOORS AND DRAWER FRONTS

1. Doors and drawer fronts must be ordered by actual door size needed, not the opening size. All sizes need to be ordered in increments of 1/16".
2. Please check minimum sizes listed below each sketch for the doors and drawer fronts that you ordered.
3. If you are using concealed hinges, please check page 42 to see if the edge you have chosen is compatible with cup hinges. All arched doors must have hinge side noted.
4. Outside edge profiles E-103 and E-107 are a 3/8" lip style. Please specify if the pairs of doors are to be edged on three sides only by indicating "Butt Door" next to the door size. If the doors are arched, please specify the butt edge by indicating "Butt Left" or "Butt Right".
5. All doors 48" + in height will automatically have a center rail added unless otherwise specified on the order form, or a center rail isn't available for that door style. Doors made without a center rail will not be guaranteed against warping.
6. All doors 24" + in width will not automatically have a center stile added. These doors will not be guaranteed against warping.

STANDARD GRADE

All of our standard grade wood is uniform in color (with the exception of Hickory) and is well suited for most light to medium-dark stain applications. Each door will be selected for uniform color and graining.

Each type of wood has its own unique characteristics some of which will be allowed, for example:

Hard Maple is a clear, white wood but it may have a few small pin knots and occasional mineral streaks seen in the machined areas of the doors. Occasional patterns of "birds eye" and "worm tracks", which are characteristic of maple, may be visible.

Cherry is a colorful wood that may have a few small pin knots and an occasional streak of sapwood in the machined areas with small gum spots and mineral flecks visible.

Red Oak may have small pin knots and occasional mineral streaks visible.

Hickory typically will have dramatic color swings from nearly white to brown and may have any combination of color seen in each door with small pin knots and mineral streaks common.

PREMIUM GRADE

Each piece will be hand-selected to ensure a superior color and grain match on the face of the doors. Very few of the natural wood characteristics allowed in the standard grade will be present on the face of the doors. Premium Grade is recommended when using a natural or very light sprayed on stain.

Premium Grade: add 20% to the List Price.

RUSTIC GRADE

Only solid wood doors and drawer fronts can be made using Rustic Grade. Each Rustic Grade will have many variations allowed such as mineral streaks, sap and heartwood. Knots are common but will be structurally sound and may have slight voids or cracks around them.

Rustic Alder will have larger cracks and knot holes allowed but they will not be greater than 1/4" in diameter.

PAINT GRADE

May have extreme color and grain variations along with mineral streaking and heartwood allowed. Because solid wood will expand and contract, we recommend that an MDF panel is used for painted finishes rather than solid wood. When an order is placed for UNFINISHED Paint Grade doors, we will use solid wood panels unless you specify MDF panels. **If we are painting the order, we will automatically substitute an MDF panel whenever possible, unless you specify a solid wood panel be used.**

VALUE GRADE

Developed for price sensitive projects and is best suited for use with Medium to Dark finishes. Value Grade will have a mixture of sap and light heartwood blended throughout as well as natural mineral streaks may be present on the face and profiled areas.

NOTE: The 1/4" Veneer panels used in our flat panel doors will generally stain darker than the solid wood frames. If a stain match is required, we recommend that a solid wood reverse panel (P-204) is used instead of the 1/4" veneer panel.

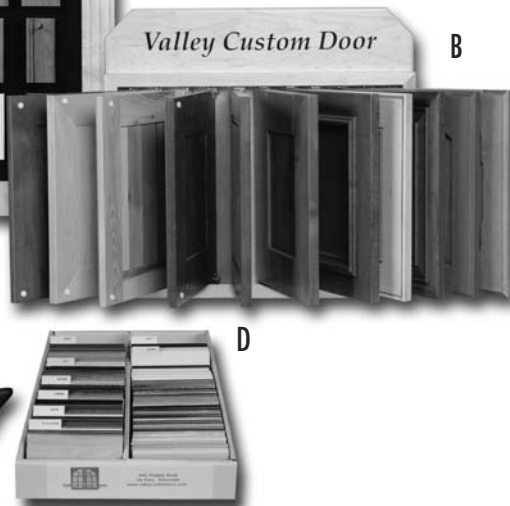

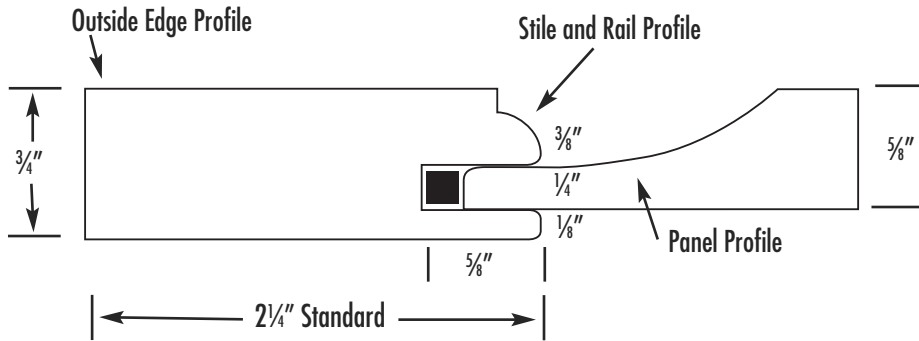

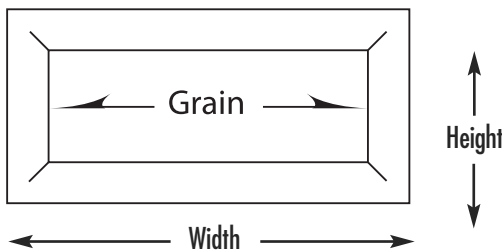
7 DOOR CONSTRUCTION

The stiles and rails of our doors are constructed by using a mortise and tenon joint. The tenon is $\frac{5}{8}$ " long to give you the strongest door available. *Our standard stile and rail width on Cope and Stick style doors is $2\frac{1}{4}$ " with the exception of style 324 and 424 which have 3" stiles and rails. Our standard center rail width is $2\frac{1}{2}$ ". The finish thickness of the doors is $\frac{3}{4}$ ". All raised panel inserts are $\frac{5}{8}$ " thick and are made out of solid wood. Flat panels are $\frac{1}{4}$ " thick and are an MDF Core Veneer material.

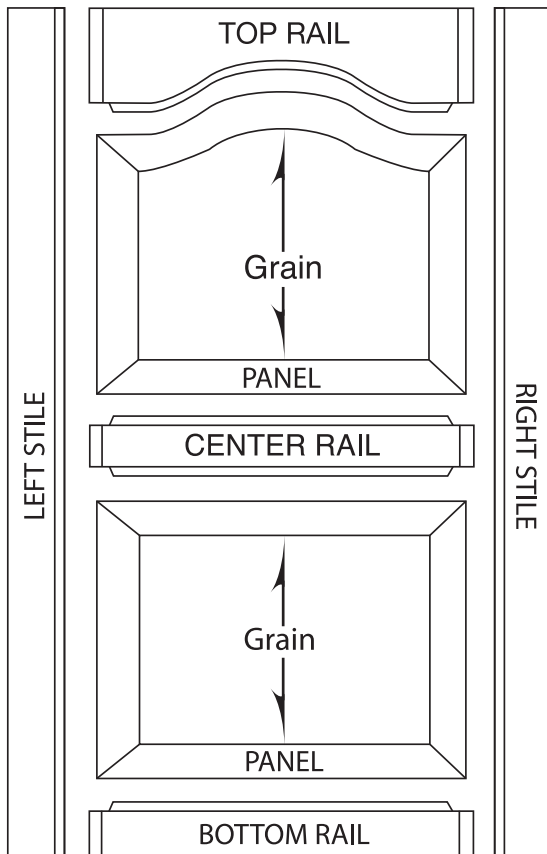
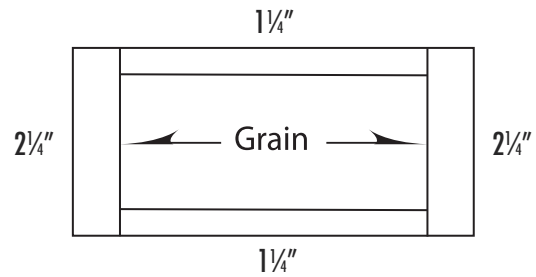

Unless otherwise specified, these holes will be placed at 3/4" down from the top and bottom of the door.

- We offer two Gloss Finishes: Satin (35-40 sheen) or Matte (15-20 sheen). See chart for availability.
- All Custom Stain or Paint Colors will have a \$XXX.XX set-up charge and will be priced by the square foot. (Price per sq. ft. may vary depending on approved sample.)
- **Please Note: Due to the nature of wood, there will be a certain degree of color grain variation between the color sample and the finished product. These variations are considered natural characteristics of wood and are standard throughout the industry.**

1. All items must be ordered on our Valley Custom Door order forms. Each different style of Mantel/Surround and Upper Panel has its own order form. Please make photocopies of the order forms provided for you in this book.
2. All orders must be received by fax or mailed to us — NO PHONE ORDERS WILL BE ACCEPTED.

Valley Custom Door will guarantee the order will be shipped as it was ordered. Orders will be acknowledged for the purpose of knowing they were received, not for making changes.

3. Mandatory size dimensions that must be filled in are:

A. Fireplace opening size including surrounding face material. We recommend that you measure the height of the fireplace face material and subtract $\frac{1}{2}$ ". We recommend that you measure the width of the fireplace face material and subtract 1". This will allow the mantel surround to overlay the face material by $\frac{1}{2}$ " on each of the three (3) sides.

B. Depth of tile or brick on back wall. We recommend that you take the actual depth of the face material and add $\frac{1}{4}$ " to allow for custom fitting if necessary. Moulding will be provided to cover any unevenness of the face material. *Note: It will be assumed that if a size dimension is missing on your order form, we are to use the standard size listed.*

4. Crown Moulding on the Upper Panels will be our standard V-30 ($3\frac{1}{4}$ " wide). The moulding will be shipped loose and must be applied to the Upper Panel at the job site.
5. Please note the minimum sizes printed on the order forms for some of the mantel components. Be certain you have allowed for these minimums on your mantel layout.
6. Standard sizes have been listed on the order forms. If you choose to vary from the standard sizes, please be aware that this will affect the dimensions for other areas as well. For example: When the depth of the mantel is reduced, the depth of the two side legs will also be reduced.
7. Double-check the wall sizes to the left and right of the mantel to ensure there is enough space available to accept the mantels and surrounds.
8. Please indicate on the order form if you would like your order unfinished or prefinished. You may select one of our standard stain colors, standard paint colors or a custom color match. *See page 56 for pricing on prefinishing.

Lead Times: Lead times will vary from week to week depending on our workload. Generally, your orders will ship as follows:

- Unfinished products - 10 business days
- Prefinished products - 15 business days

Packaging: Each mantel and surround will be packaged for shipment in four (4) pieces and must be fastened together at the job site. All pieces are packaged using heavy corrugated boxes lined with 1" styrofoam. Each piece is then placed in the box and surrounded with an expanding bagged foam material that will form to the shape of the contents and the box.

Packaging Charges will be added for each piece that is boxed and prepared for shipment by UPS or Common Carrier as follows:
